Butterfly Cakes

Can you help Connor the Caterpillar make these simple and delicious Butterfly cakes?

- You will need (for the cake):
 - Spoon
 2 tsp baking powder

 - 12 cake cases
 - 2 eggs
 - 2 eggs

 - A bun baking tray
 - 110g (koz) self-raising flour
 - 220g (8oz) leing suu
- Sharp knife
 110g (4oz) Caster sugar
 Milk

 Preheat the oven to 180C (fan)/200C (electric)
- /Gas mark 6

 Lay out 12 cake cases in a bun tin
- Mix the sugar, flour and baking powder together in a bowl
- Now add the butter/margarine and eggs an whisk it all together

 Using a spoon fill the cake cases with the
- Dusing a spoon, fill the cake cases with the mixture (be sure to fill the cases!)

 Ask an adult to help you put the tray in the oven for 15 minutes or until they are golden brown.
- Take them out of the oven and place on a cooling rack
- > For the icing whisk the butter and half the sugar together in a bowl. Once they are mixed, add the rest of the sugar and a splash of milk, continue whisking.

 You might head half from a grown up with this bit. I list a short knife to cut.

 You might need help from a grown up with this bit Use a sharp knife to cut an upside-down, shallow cone shape out the top of the cake, cut this in half. Fill the hole in the cake with icing and then place the cut-out cake on top (Illew mighs). Sprinkle some icing sugar and other decorations you want to use on top of your cakes.
